Achilles : Achilles (Ἀχιλλεύς) was the son of Peleus and the Nereid Thetis. Ligyron was the name given to Achilles at birth. While still an infant, Thetis tried to make her son immortal. One account says that she anointed Achilles in ambrosia before laying him in a fire, burning away the mortal parts of his body, making him invulnerable from ordinary weapons.

Styx was a firm ally of Zeus in the Titan Wars, who brought her children to stand beside the god in battle. Zeus rewarded her by making her stream the agent of oaths which bound the gods.
