The patient with brainstem stroke who has bilateral loss of sensation is scored 2.

Level 2 Stroke Centers. Level 2 stroke centers are appropriate for patients when a Level 1 stroke center is more than two hours away from the patient's location. Below are the criteria for a Level 2 stroke center: Must see a minimum of 100 patients per year; Must perform a minimum of 50 mechanical thrombectomies (clot removals) per year
