Cats, also called domestic cats (*Felis catus*), are small, carnivorous (meat-eating) mammals, of the family Felidae. Domestic cats are often called house cats when kept as indoor pets. Cats have been domesticated (tamed) for nearly 10,000 years. They are one of the most popular pets in the world. Their origin is probably the African Wildcat *Felis silvestris lybica*.
