The total annual budget for flying a Citation Mustang private jet 200 hours per year is approximately \$448,624 or \$667,099 for flying 400 hours per year. The maximum speed of the Citation Mustang is 483 mph, but with slower climb, cruise and descending speeds it is more likely to average 386 mph which would equate to an average cost per mile of approximately \$5.81 at 200 hours per year.
