- Church budget - Total 2009 church income was roughly the same between lean staff and other churches. - Lean staff churches have budgets from \$75,000 to over \$10,000,000, and the comparison churches have budgets in similar ranges.
- So, total budget has no meaningful relationship to how lean your staff is - or is not.

Lean Staffing: Churches That Handle Staff Costs in Under ...

Audits have become expensive, often ranging from \$5,000 to \$15,000 depending on the annual budget of the organization. An accountant or experienced church bookkeeper can perform a management review of the cash management procedures, accounts payable procedures, and the system for recording and reporting pledges and contributions.

While many experts agree that most in our congregations would be overwhelmed by examining every detail of the annual operating budget, the option should be available. The finance committee should meet regularly, and the meetings should be publicized and open to all church members.

Your budget is a clue as to what spending is important to your church, and what isn't. It's a reflection of the overall strategy and focus of your church in a given calendar year. At the very least, your ministry should set an annual spending plan based on what was spent in previous years while factoring in future goals and objectives.
