Kings of Dal Riada / Dál Riata (Gaels in Britain) Natives of the Ulster region of Ireland, the Dal Riada Scotti came under pressure from the powerful Clan Uí Neill, from whose ranks were drawn the Irish high kings. From the latter end of the fifth century this extended clan of Scotti migrated en masse to settle on the western coast of Pictland, in the modern region of Argyllshire.
