Horses with acute tendinitis are severely lame, with affected joints that are hot, painful, and swollen. In chronic tendinitis, fibrous tissues around the tendon join together, thicken, and scar. The horse may appear sound while walking or trotting but becomes lame again when put to a gallop.

Sacroiliac injury may affect a horse's performance, producing intermittent, often shifting, hindlimb lameness. The action of the hindlimbs may be

reduced, and the horse may drag the toe of one or both hooves. Sacroiliac injury is common in Standardbreds and hunter-jumper horses.
