This uses the idea of statistical deviation (SD). Normal people are within 1SD of the mean, falling within the 34.1% on either side in terms of their IQ, income, height, weight, age, level of extraversion, etc. "Odd" people are further from the mean - 2SD means in the 13.6% on either side of the normal people, so unusually clever or stupid, rich or poor, big or small, outgoing or shy.
