German immigration fell off significantly after the Revolution and did not pick up until after the 1820s when a famine set off a new wave of German immigration to North America. There were significant differences between these new German immigrants and those who are today known as the Pennsylvania Germans (those who came before the Revolution).

The German Society of Pennsylvania's library was begun in 1817, 53 years after the Society's

The tide of German immigration to Pennsylvania swelled between 1725 and 1775, with immigrants arriving as redemptioners or indentured servants.
