Several studies (Ozimek et al., 1985, Finke et al., 1989) have demonstrated that the protein quality of insects is promising regarding availability and digestibility compared to casein and soy but varies and can be improved by the removal of chitin. To consider insects as an alternative protein source, additional research on the quality of insect proteins is required.
