Stained glass is made up of many individual pieces of glass. Once a pattern has been decided upon and enlarged, glass is laid on top of the pattern and cut to that size and shape. Once all the pieces have been cut, they are assembled with strips of lead came.

How is a Stained Glass Panel Made?

The stained glass maker buys coloured glass from the glass blower or manufacturer, and the colours are already in the sheets of glass. The most expensive colour for glass is red, which is made by adding copper or gold into the mix. If windows have high proportion of red, you know that someone probably spent lot of money on them!

Make Your Own Stained Glass Frames To make your own frames, cut the wood to size using the miter allowance. The miter allowances for each size frame are listed below. Add this amount to the size of your glass panel in order to calculate the length of the outside edge of your frame.

Make Your Own Stained Glass Frames - Northern Hardwood Frames

Start cutting the glass, doing one lamp panel at a time. I have seen too many mistakes happen when all of the glass is cut before it is fitted and foiled. You can either cut, foil and solder one panel at a time, or cut and fit each panel, put the pieces away and do the next, saving the foiling and soldering until the last panel is cut.
