History. The symbol was originally introduced in 1770 by Nicolas de Condorcet, who used it for a partial differential, and adopted for the partial derivative by Adrien-Marie Legendre in 1786. It represents a specialized cursive type of the letter d, just like the integral sign originates as a specialized type of a long s (first used in print by Leibniz in 1686).
