Because many corals, coralline algae, and other calcifying organisms require both calcium and alkalinity (as bicarbonate), it is necessary to continually ensure that adequate amounts of these elements are present. Unfortunately, there is a natural tendency toward the abiotic (nonbiological) precipitation of insoluble calcium carbonate from the water as calcium ions and carbonate ions combine.

The carbonate ion ( $\text{CO}_3$ ) has a valency of -2 and forms compounds with sodium (Na), which has a valency of +1, and calcium (Ca), which has a valency of +2. The resulting compounds are sodium carbonate ( $\text{Na}_2\text{CO}_3$ ) and calcium carbonate ( $\text{CaCO}_3$ ). The former is known as soda ash or washing soda, and the latter, known as calcite, is a primary component of chalk, limestone and marble.

Calcium carbonate is strongly heated until it undergoes thermal decomposition to form calcium oxide and carbon dioxide. The calcium oxide (unslaked lime) is dissolved in water to form calcium hydroxide (limewater). Bubbling carbon dioxide through this forms a milky suspension of calcium carbonate.
