Most of the tests took place at the Nevada Test Site (NNTS/NTS) and the Pacific Proving Grounds in the Marshall Islands and off Kiritimati Island in ...

One hundred atmospheric nuclear tests were detonated at the Nevada Test Site (originally the Nevada Proving Grounds) between 1951 and 1963. The first Nevada series, code-named Ranger, was conducted during January and February 1951, immediately after President Harry S. Truman had approved the establishment of a continental test site in Nevada.
