The initial response of children and many adults to violent media is fear and anxiety (e.g., Cantor, 1998). When violent stimuli are repeatedly presented in a positive emotional context (e.g., exciting background music, sound effects, visual effects, rewards for violent actions in the game), these initial distressing reactions are reduced.
